Supplementary Sailing Instructions

- 1. Race office and Signal pole
- 1.1 Race office is located in GKSS club house.
- 1.2 Signals made ashore will be displayed on the flag pole marked with an orange flag next to the berthing ramp.
- 1.3 When flag AP is displayed ashore, '1 minute' is replaced with 'not less than 45 minutes' in RRS Race Signals.


3 Marks

- 3.1 The startmark will be a boat with orange flag.

 The 1st Roundingmark and the Gatebouys are red conical bouys.

 The spreader mark will be a red ball bouy.

 The finish mark is a flag bouy with a blue flag
- 3.2 Upon a change of a leg, the replacement bouy will be an white cylinder (see 6.5 for procedure)
- 4 The Course
- 4.1 The Course (see sketch below) shall be sailed: START 1 2 3A/3B (Gate) 1 2 3A FINISH
- 4.2 If, Flag 3 (RED/WHITE/BLUE) is displayed, no later than together with the Warning signal an extra lap is added. The Course (see sketch below) shall then be sailed: START 1 2 3A/3B (Gate) 1 2 3A/3B (Gate) 1 2 3A FINISH



5 Time limits

- 5.1 The race time limit is 45 min
- 5.2 The finishing window is 15 min.

6. Changes and additions to appendix S

- 6.1 To alert boats that a new starting sequence is about to begin, the orange flag on the starting line will be displayed with a sound signal not less than <u>two minutes</u> before the warning signal. This changes Appenix S 5.2
- 6.2 The class flag will be Flag F (white with red romb). This changes Appendix S 6.1
- 6.3 The startline is between the orange flags displayed on the start vessel and the startmark. This changes Appendix S 9.2
- 6.4 A boat that does not start within <u>four minutes</u> after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start (DNS) without a hearing. This changes RRS A5.1 and A5.2
- 6.5 RRS 33 is changed to:
 - While boats are racing, the race committee may change a leg of the course.
 - (a) Minor adjustments can be made by changing the position of the next mark or gate before the first boat has rounded the previous mark, adjustments will be made without signalling.
 - (b) Other adjustments will be made by placing the replacement mark before the first boat has rounded the previous mark and signalling all boats before they begin the leg.If a further adjustment is made and a new replacement mark is placed this mark will be the original bouy.

Signal flag C together with repetitive sounds is a sufficient signal when changing position of the new mark. This changes RRS 33.
