



## Notice of Race (NoR) for Marstrand Race Days

Regatta:	SWEDISH CHAMPIONSHIP (SC) FOR J70	
Dates:	5 – 8 June, 2025	
Location:	Marstrand, Sweden	
Level:	Red/National	
Boat Class:	J70	
Organizing authority:	Marstrands Segelsällskap (MaSS)	

#### 1. Rules

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2025 2028 ("RRS").
- 1.2 Class rules for J70 will apply with the following changes: the outboard engine may be replaced by one or two containers of water with a minimum total weight of 20kg. The container(s) must be secured to a permanent location on board. This amends C5.3 of the class rules.
- 1.3 All boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority, in accordance with World Sailing Advertising Code, Regulation 20.
- 1.4 RRS 40.1 will apply at all times while the boat is afloat and on the water. However, it does not apply on a keelboat when it is moored or when the competitor is below deck. A boat breaking this rule may be warned or penalized at the discretion of the protest committee.
- 1.5 The official language is English. If there is a conflict between languages, the English text will take precedence.
- 1.6 In the event of a discrepancy between the Notice of Race ("NoR") and the Sailing Instructions ("SI"), the SI shall take precedence.
- 1.7 When the water temperature is below +14°C competitors shall wear clothes that prevent hypothermia, i.e., a wetsuit or a drysuit.
- 1.8 It is permitted to have a VHF radio on board to be able to listen to channel 72 or the channel announced by the race committee.
- 1.9 VHF Radio may be used in an emergency situation and/or to enable communication with the race committee.





- 1.10 Mobile phones or similar devices may only be used in an emergency. Use is also permitted between races.
- 1.11 Swedish time indication will apply.

#### 2. Eligibility

- 2.1 All boats competing shall be insured so that the person in charge is covered for liability claims up to at least 5 million Swedish kronor.
- 2.2 The event is open class.
- 2.3 Every competitor shall be a member of a club that is a member of the Swedish Sailing Federation or her national authority. A person in charge, who is a Swedish citizen, shall have a competition license (Tävlingslicens) issued by the Swedish Sailing Federation.
- 2.4 Boats with ownership or registration in Russia or Belarus, or boats with competitors who are Russian or Belarusian citizens, are not allowed to participate in the competition.
- 2.5 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race. The organizing authority accepts no liability for any damage to property or personal injury suffered by anyone in connection with or before, during or after the regatta.
- 2.6 By participating or intending to participate in a competition conducted under the rules, each competitor and boat owner agrees to accept the rules, see RRS 4.
- 2.7 At a Swedish Championship, a competitor must be at least twelve years old in the year the competition is held.

#### 3. Entry

3.1 Boats may enter the event by registering online at Sailarena no later than the dates specified under 3.3

3.2 The registration must contain information about: Boat type Sail number Helmsman's first and last name Mobile number E-mail Postal address City/Town Club Name of whole crew





3.3 Registration fees

1. **Early registration – "Early Bird"** can be made during the period March 2025 – April 30, 2025.

Registration fee SEK 2,800.

**2. Regular registration** can be made during the period May 1, 2025 – May 23, 2025

Registration fee SEK 3,500.

**3. Late registration** can be made during the period May 24, 2025 – June 5, 2025. Registration fee SEK 4,000.

Payment is made through Sailarena upon registration, see point 3.1.

#### The registration fee includes:

- 1. Port fee for mooring at H-pier Marstrandsön.
- 2. Launching/lifting with MaSS crane at Fiskholmskajen.
- 3. "After-sail" at the H-jetty.
- 4. Competition fee to the Swedish Sailing Association; 100 SEK/boat.
- 5. Sanction fee to the West Coast Sailing Association; 42 SEK/boat.
- 6. Prizes.
- 7. MaSS costs for the event.
- 3.4 The registration fee will be refunded, minus MaSS bank costs, if cancellation is submitted before the last regular registration date of May 23, 2025 via email to race@marstrandsss.se.

#### 4. Arrival notification and equipment inspection

- 4.1 Arrival notification, or late registration, must be made on Thursday June 5, 2025 between 5:00 PM and 7:00 PM. Arrival notification, however not late registration, can also be made on Friday June 6, 2025 between 8:00 AM and 9:00 AM.
- 4.2 The person in charge shall upon request be able to verify club membership and valid measurement certificate or similar when so required.
- 4.3 Boats' sails must be measured and stamped or provided with the J70 Class Association's sail-tag, which shows that the sails are measured and approved.

The race committee is not responsible for the measurement of sails.

4.4 A boat, crew or equipment may be inspected at any time. On the water the race committee or the technical committee may direct a boat to a specified site for inspection.





- 4.5 Damaged or lost equipment may not be replaced without written permission from the race committee. Requests for this should be made to the race committee at the earliest occasion
- 4.6 A competitor that has become ill or injured may be replaced after approval by the race committee. However, the person in charge may not be changed.
- 4.7 Random checks of safety equipment may occur.

#### 5. Sailing instructions and information

5.1 Sailing instructions and other official information will be available on the official noticeboard (ONB) at:

5.2 The race committee will, if possible and appropriate broadcast information regarding the course, starting times, safety etc. on VHF channel 72\*.

\* VHF channel may be changed, which in such case will be announced at the skippers' meeting or at sea before the starting procedure.

6.2 No start procedure after 15.00 Sunday June 8, 2025.

#### 7. Format

- 7.1 9 races are scheduled.
- 7.2 The regatta will be implemented as fleet racing in a straight series.

#### 8. Venue and course

- 8.1 The races are primarily held on the Marstrandsfjord course areas A B, see Addendum 1 "Marstrands Race Days Course areas".
- 8.2 The course will be a windward/leeward course as described in the sailing instructions.

#### 9. Protests and penalties

- 9.1 With change to RRS 44.1, the two-turn penalty is changed to a one-turn penalty.
- 9.2 RRS T1 will apply.

#### 10. Scoring

- 10.1 RRS A5.3 will apply.
- 10.2 With change to RRS 90.3, the sailing committee will not make any changes to the results 12 hours after the last race.
- 10.3 RRS A2.1 is changed so that with five or less races, no score will be excluded. After more than five races the worst score will be excluded.
- 10.4 Three races are required to constitute a championship.

#### 11. Prizes

- 11.1 MaSS prizes for first, second and third place
  - · Class associations' own prizes.
  - National Sports Federation's SM plaques for first, second and third place For the awarding of championship badges, the SSF Competition Regulations 2024, Chapter 8 Championship Provisions apply.





- The winner of the Swedish Championship is invited to the Sailing Master competition according to the terms and conditions stated in the invitation for that competition. Registration for the Sailing Master must be made in Sailarena no later than 14 days after the Swedish Championship has been completed.
- Any other sponsor's prizes.


